2 weeks	Well visit
1 month	Well visit
2 months	VAXELIS® #1 (DTaP, Hib, IPV, Hepatitis B #2) Pevnar® #1 Rotateq® #1
4 months	VAXELIS® #2 (DTaP, Hib, IPV, Hepatitis B #3) Pevnar® #2 Rotateq® #2
6 months	VAXELIS® #3 (DTaP, Hib IPV, Hepatitis B #4) Pevnar® #3 Rotateq® #3
9 months	Complete blood count (CBC) Lead level
12 months	MMR Pevnar® #4 PPD (if indicated)
15 months	Vision screening Hepatitis A #1 Varicella

Age	Recommended Vaccines and Screenings
18 months	DTaP #4 Hib #4 Lead level Complete blood count (CBC)
2 years	Hepatitis A #2
2½–3 years	Exams Catch-up vaccines
4–6 years	Yearly exams Quadracel® (DTaP, polio) Proquad® (MMR, varicella) PPD (if indicated) Lead level (if indicated)
11 years	Tdap Menactra® #1 / MenQuadfi® #1 Gardasil® #1 (two-part series) PPD (if indicated) Cholesterol screening
12–15 years	Yearly exams Gardasil® #2 (if Gardasil® #1 given at ≥ 15 years, needs three-part series) Cholesterol screening
16–18 years	Yearly exams Menactra® #2 / MenQuadfi® #2 Trumenba® (if indicated) Cholesterol screening
